1. IIA Legacy Competition

1.1. IIA Legacy Competition Definition

- 1.1.1. IIA recognized non-qualifying open competition with event dates currently set on the IIA calendar and are hosted annually by the same club.

1.2. IIA Legacy Competition Eligibility

- 1.2.1. Hosting club must be a member of IIA for a minimum of 3 consecutive years.
- 1.2.2. IIA club membership must be renewed annually.
- 1.2.3. Hosting club must stay in good standing with USFS.
- 1.2.4. If the hosting club does not keep in good standing with either IIA or USFS, the event will lose its legacy status and position on the calendar.
- 1.2.5. Event must be hosted during same calendar time frame. Any significant date changes such as month must be discussed with interclub.
- 1.2.6. Event must be hosted yearly.
- 1.2.7. Exception for unusual circumstances will be granted with IIA discussion.
- 1.2.8. Event may not be hosted during the same month as another IIA Legacy Competition.

1.3. IIA Legacy Competitions (Current)

- 1.3.1. January - Snake River Skatefest hosted by Idaho Falls FSC
- 1.3.2. June – SkateFest hosted by the Centennial Park FSC
- 1.3.3. August – Copper Cup hosted by Utah FSC
- 1.3.4. September – Oktoberfest hosted by Cottonwood Heights

2. IIA Rotating Competition

2.1. IIA Rotating Competition Definition

- 2.1.1. IIA competition with host club rotating annually between all Utah clubs that do not host a Legacy Competition or Probationary Competition.

2.2. IIA Rotating Competition Eligibility

- 2.2.1. If a club hosts a non-qualifying competition required to be sanctioned by USFS the club will not be eligible to host an IIA Rotating Competition. (Contact USFS with questions)

2.2.2. If a club ceases to host a legacy competition and requests to be included in the IIA Rotating Competition Schedule it will be added to the end of the list before the repeat of the club hosting the event for the current year IIA was notified.

2.2.3. If an additional rotating competition is added the club will be placed in the middle of the rotation so each event will be held several years apart.

3. IIA Basic Skills Competition

3.1. IIA Basic Skills Competition Definition

3.1.1. Basic Skills Competitions may include events for skaters who have passed no higher than the preliminary free skating, preliminary dance or adult bronze free skating tests without applying for a U.S. Figure Skating sanction. However, an approval number is required from the appointed Basic Skills representative. (USFS Basic Skills Manual, Rule# 3111)

- 4.2.2. Host club must forfeit IIA Rotating Competition eligibility.
- 4.2.3. Competition shall not be hosted the same month as a Legacy Competition.
